Nicki graduated from the R(D)SVS in 1988 and returned to the University of Edinburgh in 1999 to run the general practice. From 2004-2007 she was the Senior Clinical Scholar in Feline Medicine, sponsored by the Feline Advisory Bureau. This led to Nicki gaining the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons Diploma in Small Animal Medicine (Feline) in 2008, followed by the Diploma of the European College of Veterinary Internal Medicine in 2009. Nicki is currently the only person within the UK to hold both these Diplomas and is a Recognised European Veterinary Specialist in Internal Medicine.

Nicki's areas of clinical interest include emergency medicine, renal disease and haematology and she is also a keen teacher of undergraduate students, residents and general practitioners. Nicki was appointed Head of the Feline Clinic in 2012, but also devotes 30% of her clinic time to the ICU rotation and care of emergency canine patients.
